1/ APPROVAL OF DESIGN

No monument shall be erected or placed on any lot until its design and the plans and specifications relative to the material, construction and the proposed location thereof shall have been submitted to the General Manager and shown to meet all applicable Bylaws.

2/ DEFINITION OF A MONUMENT

For the purpose of these Bylaws, a monument shall be understood to be any permanent memorial structure projecting above the level of the ground.

3/ INSCRIPTION

No inscription shall be placed on any monument, marker or columbarium tablet which is not in keeping with the dignity and decorum of the Cemetery. No lettering will be allowed on the side of a monument facing an adjoining lot where there is not room for a grave between the monument and the boundary of the lot.

4/ ONLY ONE MONUMENT TO A LOT

Not more than one monument shall be erected on any lot. No Monuments shall be allowed on single graves except in Section C (Muslim). Refer to Bylaws for dimensions of monuments.

5/ DIMENSIONS OF MONUMENTS

Monuments on two grave lots shall not exceed 4' in height including base, bottom base 3' in length by 1' 8" wide.

Monuments on three grave lots shall not exceed 5' in height, bottom base 4' 6" in length by 1' 10" wide.

Monuments on four grave lots should not exceed 6' in height, bottom base 6' in length by 1' 10" wide.

Monuments from 4' to 6' in height must be 10" thick.

In monument areas where there are lots larger than four graves, the length of the base shall not exceed fifty percent of the width of the lot by 1' 10" wide by 6' in height. Neither the diestone, nor any part of a monument, may exceed the length or width of the base.

6/ THICKNESS OF MONUMENT

No monument shall be less than 8" in thickness at its narrowest point.

7/ FREE STANDING CROSSES

Monuments in the form of free standing crosses must conform to the provisions set out in Bylaws and must be at least 8" in thickness.

8/ BASES

When a base and diestone are used, the base shall be on the same material as the diestone. High bases are not favoured by the Cemetery and unless of specially approved design shall not exceed TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL HEIGHT OF THE MONUMENT. Bases for the monuments must be of a "rock-pitch" finish.

9/ DOWELLING

All diestones, columns, limbs of crosses, etc., shall be adequately dowelled to their bases unless the underside of each superstructure is, in the judgement of the General Manager of sufficient area in relation to its height to ensure stability.

10/OPEN URNS

Open urns intended as receptacles for flowers are not permitted.

11/FOUNDATIONS

The Company retains exclusivity to the installation of foundations in the cemetery. The foundation of a monument shall be built in the designated space and a 2" border of concrete will be added to the exact dimension of the base in order to facilitate maintenance. Detailed information is available at the office. If incorrect dimensions have been given on the application form, the foundation will be removed and rebuilt by the Cemetery at the expense of the Dealer.

12/MATERIAL

All monuments shall be constructed of granite. The bottom bed of all bases must be cut level and true.

13/TOLERANCE IN DIMENSIONS

A tolerance of 1/4" may be permitted over and under the specified dimensions of a monument or parts of a monument.

14/IDENTIFICATION

In order to facilitate identification and reduce vandalism, all monuments installed in future, regardless of size and material, shall show the section and the lot number in the lower right hand corner of the die in a legible and permanent manner. The numbers shall not exceed 1/2" in height.
